# THE PAGE FAMILIES OF BARTON STACEY, HAMPSHIRE

Very little is known of the family called Page who were resident in Barton Stacey in the early to mid-1700s.

**JAMES PAGE**, perhaps brother or cousin to John Page (see below), married Elizabeth \_\_?\_\_ (whose surname is presently unknown). He was presumably the James Page buried at Barton Stacey on 15 May 1732. Elizabeth Page was buried on 4 December 1737.

### Children of James and Elizabeth Page, baptised at Barton Stacey,

- i. John, baptised 26 January 1714/5.
- ii. Stephen, baptised 7 April 1717. He married Mary Bird on 30 November 1741 at Barton Stacey. Stephen Page, or perhaps a child of his, died in 1744 and was buried at Barton Stacey on 15 July.
- iii. Sarah, baptised 17 January 1719/20. Sarah Page was buried at Barton Stacey on 20 May 1735.

**JOHN PAGE** was said to be of the parish of Shalden, Hampshire when he married Mary Martin of Alton, Hampshire on 20 April 1718/9 at All Saints', Barton Stacey. Nothing further is presently known of this couple in Barton Stacey.

#### **NOTES**

John Tripick married Ruth Page on 30 June 1734 at Barton Stacey.

Henry Marshman of 'Down Hursborn' married Elizabeth Page of Barton Stacey on 11 October 1767 at Barton Stacey. The marriage was witnessed by Sarah Page (and Richard Spratt, who witnessed many marriages around this time).

George Page, aged 15-19, was a farm labourer at Street Farm in Barton Stacey village at the time of the 1841 census. He does not appear in later censuses.

**HENRY GEORGE PAGE**, born about 1880 in Wonston, married Emily Bourne of Old Basing in 1898. They lived for a few years in Barton Stacey parish, between roughly 1903 and 1906. They were living by the time of the 1908 in Winchester.

- i. Ernest, born 1901 in Sutton Scotney.
- ii. Reginald Arthur, born on 7 June 1903 in Newton Stacey and baptised on 27 August 1905 at Barton Stacey Methodist Chapel.

- iv. Frederick Charles, born 1908 in Winchester.
- v. Alfred George, born 1911.
